# HB 129, 279, 329, AND 633

# DIVERT PUBLIC FUNDING TO PRIVATE SCHOOLS AND VIOLATE MONTANA'S CONSTITUTION

The Montana constitution is clear: every student has the right to a **free quality** public education. Public funds shall not be appropriated to private corporations.

#### **HB 129**

- **HB 129** expands Montana's 529 College Education Savings Account program to include private, for-profit, and religious k-12 education expenses.
- Unlike eligible colleges, k-12 schools that receive tax-preferred dollars do not need to meet any accreditation or accountability standards.
- HB 129 incentivizes the unaccountable privatization of Montana's schools.

## **HB 279**

- HB 279 increases the tax credit an individual or corporation can receive for donating to for-profit and private schools -- by 1,333%!
- Under HB 279, wealthy individuals and corporations could receive a \$200,000 tax credit when they financially support private institutions. This massive tax giveaway will starve essential public services and public education in Montana.
- To make matters worse, HB 279
  eliminates any oversight and
  accountability to ensure all students
  receive a quality education.

#### **HB 329**

- HB 329 forces public schools to send state and local dollars to private institutions.
- These private institutions receiving public funds don't have to be accredited or even located in Montana.
- HB 329 is a blatant violation of the Montana constitution.

### **HB 633**

- HB 633 creates a publicly funded charter school system in Montana with no elected school board, no accreditation, and no required physical presence in the state.
- HB 633 would allow tax dollars to be diverted from Montana's quality public schools to fund for-profit, unaccountable institutions.
- HB 633 allows charter schools to discriminate against students with special needs.
